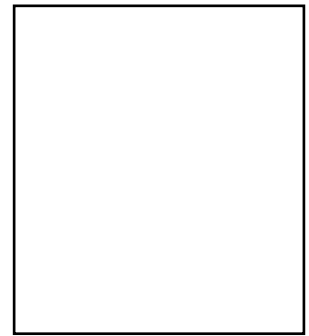

MEMBERSHIP RULES

1. The Durham Light Infantry Association exists for the following reasons:-
 - a) To maintain the spirit of the Durham Light Infantry, the Light Infantry and The Rifles amongst all ranks.
 - b) To keep in touch with those who have served in the Durham Light Infantry, the Light Infantry, and The Rifles.
 - c) To maintain the comradeship existing in the Armed Forces of the Crown and to promote social intercourse between former service personnel and other with an interest in these regiments.
 - d) To afford opportunities of mutual assistance and, co-operation with service charities to investigate cases of distress and hardship and to obtain or give assistance, when possible.
2. **Membership** Eligible for membership of the DLI Association are:-
 - a) All those who have worn the cap badge of the DLI, former county regiments, Light Infantry or Rifles whether Regular, Territorial Army, Reserve Army, Cadets or members of overseas linked regiments.
 - b) All other service personnel including serving and former members of the Armed Forces of the Crown.
 - c) Civilians, both men and women considered to be of the appropriate calibre as approved by the Executive Committee.
3. **Honorary Membership**
 - a) Honorary Membership may be awarded by the Executive Committee to an individual who has given notable outstanding service to the Association.
